Missa Brevis St. Joannes de Deo

Franz Joseph Haydn

The *Missa brevis Sancti Joannis de Deo* was written around 1775 for the order of the Barmherzige Bruder (Brothers Hospitallers) in Eisenstadt, whose patron saint was St. John of God. Scored for soprano solo, choir, strings and organ, it is known as *Kleine Orgelsolomesse* (Little Organ Mass) due to the extended organ solo in the *Benedictus* Movement.

It is customary to bless your house at Epiphany! Blessed chalk will be available after the Masses on Epiphany for you to take home and the Rite of Blessing will be included in the 8 January bulletin!

Candlemas is a solemnity celebrating Jesus' presentation at the temple. It is one of the oldest feasts and has been celebrated since the fourth century. Candles are available to be purchased in advance to be blessed at Candlemas. Envelopes are located in the back of the church. Sets of candles will be \$5. **Deadline for payment is 9 January 2017.** Envelopes can be placed in the collection or returned to the Parish Office at 119 Broad Street. Blessed candles will be available for pickup after the 12:05 Mass on 2 February or in the Parish Office after 2 February.

Sacrament of Marriage

Either the bride or the groom must be a practicing Catholic and registered at the Cathedral for at least twelve months before scheduling a wedding date and beginning the six month marriage preparation. The bride/groom must be an active parishioner, regularly attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, and use of the envelope system in support of the parish.
