

## **Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy**

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. 

## RECTOR'S CORNER

Pentecost - 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

And so we arrive to the great feast of Pentecost – the premier feast of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the third divine Person of the Most Holy Trinity, and it is the Holy Spirit who accomplishes all the works of God. For example, God created everything out of nothing. The actual act of creation was accomplished by the action of the Holy Spirit. When the Angel Gabriel announced God's plan to the Virgin Mary (*Luke 1:26-38*), and when she said her universe-altering "Yes," it was by the action of the Holy Spirit that Jesus was conceived in her. During Holy Mass, the priest speaks the words of Christ over the bread and wine, but it is the action of the Holy Spirit which accomplishes the change of the bread and wine into Christ's own Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

Today we wear the color of fire, the flame of the Holy Spirit, who came upon the Apostles and disciples gathered together with our Blessed Mother Mary in prayer on this holy day in the Upper Room (see Acts 1:14; 2:1-11). Tongues of flame descended upon them all as the Holy Spirit filled them with all the supernatural gifts they would need to spread the faith, just as He filled you through your own Baptism and Confirmation. Yes, you are equipped to spread the faith wherever you go just as Mary and the first Apostles and disciples did when they set the world on fire for Jesus Christ.

The Holy Spirit is alive and active *today*. While many see only decline in faith and morals all around (and that is true), look carefully with me and you will also see people coming to this very parish, who are on fire with God's love. I see it in you, our young adults and our older adults... I see it in those of you who are in-between the two. The Holy Spirit is active in the faithful single or those married, and those blessed with wonderful children. I see it in those coming for Bible studies and other faith formation. I see it always.

On the priestly vocations front: This past Friday (May 26), our Bishop ordained two young men to the transitional diaconate: Erik Roman and Peter O'Steen. Both will be ordained next year to the priesthood. On June 9, he will ordain another young man, Deacon Paul Lacombe, to the Holy Order of priest right here at the Cathedral at 6pm. In our own parish, we can see the Holy Spirit alive and inspiring holy vocations. Two of our parishioners, Michael Tracy and John Irwin, are in formation and only have a few years to go. Also, how blessed the Church is that another young man from our parish, John McBurney, has just been accepted to college seminary and will be entering this fall. I'll mention a bit more about John next week. In the meantime, keep praying for vocations! It is working!
