#### **Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy**

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. The bride/groom must meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements. The Wedding Policy Booklet may be found on the Cathedral Website. **Baptisms:** Parents desiring Baptism of their children must be registered at the Cathedral Parish and meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements. Palm Sunday – 2023 Rector's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Make time for Jesus... Holy Week begins, our most sacred week of the year. These are the days that define who we are as Christians – as disciples. Come, walk with Jesus in His final steps. Some spiritual advice: Don't try to "find time" to attend these awe-inspiring liturgies. You won't "find" the time... One must make the time to spend with Him like we do with anyone we love. A few highlights of the week:

Tuesday (April 4) at 11:00am – Priests of the diocese flock to the Cathedral for the Holy Mass of the Oils (Chrism Mass). Three oils are blessed for use in the Sacraments: Oil of the Sick for the Anointing of the Sick; Oil of Catechumens, used before Baptism; and the Sacred Chrism for the baptism of infants, for Confirmation, and for the ordination of bishops and priests. Priests also renew their ordination promises at this Mass. (This Mass takes the place of our normal daily Mass.)

Holy Thursday (April 6): The Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00pm celebrates both the institution of the Holy Mass and the Priesthood. As Mass ends, we go with Jesus, truly present in the Most Blessed Sacrament, in procession around the interior of the church to our own Garden of Gethsemane – the Altar of Repose. "Could you not watch with me one hour?" (St. Matthew 26:40). The Cathedral will remain open until 10pm for solemn prayer. (Please note that there is no 12:05pm daily Mass or 11am Confessions this day.)

Good Friday (April 7): A day of both fast & also abstinence from meat. The Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion at 3:00pm is the high point of the day. (3pm marks the traditional time the Lord died on the Cross.) I will also make myself available for confessions 10:00-11:30am in the upper church.

Holy Saturday evening (April 8): We begin with the Great Easter Vigil outside in front of the Cathedral at 8:30pm. (Please note that is no 5:30pm Mass on Holy Saturday.) This ancient liturgy is entirely unique. Full disclosure: It does last around two and a half hours (we are in vigil, after all), and it is one of the most beautiful and inspiring liturgies of Holy Mother Church. On this night, those who have been preparing to enter the Church through Baptism or a Profession of Faith will be brought into full, visible communion with the Catholic Church.

Easter Sunday (April 9): The Church rejoices to celebrate Jesus truly risen from the dead in His glorified body. Holy Mass with Bishop Fabre-Jeune at 10am. We also have Mass at 8am and Solemn Mass at 12:30pm.

Let us pray more fervently for each other in this holiest of weeks.






