Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. Baptisms: Parents desiring Baptism of their children must be registered at the Cathedral Parish and meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements. 5th Sunday of Lent – 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Ever more deeply now we delve into our Lenten observance on this Fifth Sunday of Lent, the beginning of what is traditionally known as **Passiontide**. It is amazing what we often take for granted until it is taken from our sight. The crucifix, so familiar to us Catholics, can run the risk of losing its incredible impact. This was humiliation in the ancient world, now become the symbol of the greatest possible love and humility. It is the image of the total self-gift of Jesus for His bride, the Church – for you and me. This is precisely what He continues to do through the Most Holy Eucharist. The Holy Cross will be solemnly unveiled during the Passion Liturgy of Good Friday. Other images remain veiled until the Great Easter Vigil when all veils will be removed, and we will see again with, hopefully, a renewed understanding and appreciation of Our Lord and His Saints.

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday, the beginning of our most solemn week of the year, a week so holy we even call it **Holy Week**. Please note the schedule, which you will find in this bulletin and online. First, there is no daily Mass or confessions on April 4, Tuesday of Holy Week. All the priests will be here at the Cathedral for the annual Mass of the Oils (Chrism Mass). You are invited to join us at 11am to witness the blessing of the sacramental oils. Also, all priests present will renew the promises we made on the day of our ordination. Hold us to our promises!

Confession is an integral part of our preparation for Easter joy. Here at the Cathedral, we offer many times for confession. Please, please, please do not wait until the last minute to go! Lines then are often very long, and you don't want to add extreme impatience to any list you might have!

We have a special blessing this week! On Friday, March 31, three nuns from the religious Order, the Sisters of Life, will be here along with our Vicar for Vocations, Fr. Rhett Williams, for a special Holy Hour for Vocations before our poignantly beautiful Choral Stations of the Cross. Here is the schedule: 5-6pm – Holy Hour; 6-7pm Choral Stations. After the Stations, the Sisters will join the Knights of Columbus Fish Fry for a little Q & A. See you there!

Finally, some of you may have heard that I have been appointed one of the vicars general for the diocese, effective April 3. Although this appointment will involve much work at the Pastoral Center (the Chancery), please know that I will still be present for you. I take my spiritual fatherhood very seriously and want to be a true spiritual father to the Cathedral family. Please offer a prayer for me as I take on this office and know that you and your family are always in my daily prayers.


