

Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. Baptisms: Parents desiring Baptism of their children must be registered at the Cathedral Parish and meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements. Easter Sunday – 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

If you are visiting with us here at the Cathedral for Easter, welcome and Happy Easter! I'd ask each parishioner to reach out and welcome someone this weekend. If they happen to also be a regular parishioner, then you've made a new friend!

"Christ is risen!" "Indeed, He is risen!" This traditional Easter greeting expresses not only our Christian faith in Jesus' glorious Resurrection, but also the fulfillment of the words of the Prophets. The bodily, historical resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead also prefigures what Christ will do for you and me. "He will change our lowly body to conform with His glorified body by the power that enables Him also to bring all things into subjection to Himself" (Philippians 3:21).

Looking back a bit farther in Sacred Scripture: "Your dead shall live; their bodies shall rise. O dwellers in the dust, awake and sing for joy!" (Isaiah 26:19). And the Prophet Daniel speaks of the dead awakening "some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, and those who turn many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever" (Daniel 12:2-3). In other words, we didn't just make this up. Jesus, the Word of God incarnate, fulfills Scripture. In his incredible book Jesus of Nazareth, then Cardinal Ratzinger wrote, "Jesus' resurrection was about breaking out into an entirely new form of life, into a life that is no longer subject to the laws of dying and becoming, but lies beyond it – a life that opens up a new dimension of human existence. Jesus has not returned to a normal human life in this world like Lazarus. He has entered upon a different life, he has entered the vast breadth of God himself, and it is from there that he reveals himself to his followers" (Jesus of Nazareth, 244; emphasis mine).

A few days before His Resurrection, Jesus would say to His friend Martha, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die" (John 11: 25-26). To possess belief in Christ, to share in His Body and Blood in the Most Holy Eucharist, is to have even now in a glimpse of resurrection. Even if we die, we shall live! Death no longer has power to inspire fear within us. To live and believe in the risen Christ is to be free from even the fear of death. Jesus followed up this line by asking Martha – and you and me today – "Do you believe this?" With firm Easter faith, we can respond with Martha, "Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world" (John 11:27).

On behalf of Bishop Fabre and the Deacons and staff of the Cathedral, have a blessed Easter.
