## **Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy**

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. The bride/groom must meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements. The Wedding Policy Booklet may be found on the Cathedral Website. **Baptisms:** Parents desiring Baptism of their children must be registered at the Cathedral Parish and meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements. ### RECTOR'S CORNER

5th Sunday of Easter - 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

And so we arrive to the month of May (already!)... a month dedicated in a special way to our Blessed Mother Mary. At the end of the 9am Mass, we will bless the floral crown for Our Lady and crown our beautiful, historic statue of Mary. Our children, who last Sunday received their First Holy Communion, are our special guests and will assist us in the May crowning.

So, why honor the Blessed Virgin Mary at all? First, of course we do not worship Mary. Catholics only worship and have always only worshiped the one true God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; and we recognize Jesus as the sole Mediator between God and man. Scripture also tells us, "The fervent prayer of a righteous person is very powerful" (James 5:16). We frequently ask each other, "Pray for me," perhaps before surgery, during a crisis, or another significant event. When you ask someone to pray for you, you are not trying to "get around" Jesus. We are merely fulfilling Scripture. Mary was proclaimed "full of grace" (Luke 1:28). Saint Elizabeth calls her both "blessed...among women" and "the mother of my Lord" (Luke 1:42, 43). In Scripture Mary says, "All generations will call me blessed" (Luke 1:48). Mary, now alive forever in Christ, prays for us to her Son constantly in heaven. She always and without fail points the way to the safe harbor of her Son as a good mother and Star of the Sea.

We have a special treat this coming Saturday, May 13 at the 5:30pm Mass! Please come help Bishop Fabre celebrate his first anniversary as Bishop of our Diocese. Can you believe it has already been a year? (That's probably a question to ask the Bishop!) Also, I would like to encourage you especially to bring your children to the Mass, knowing how much the Bishop loves speaking directly to them. Following the Mass, join us in the parish hall for a reception. Let us continue to pray for our bishop, especially as he celebrates this first milestone!

Finally, there is a great hunger to take our faith past simple Sunday Mass attendance. More and more, Catholics are expressing an interest in "taking it to the next level." That is done with a combination of both prayer and study. Good resources for expanding one's knowledge in the faith leads to more prayer. One great new resource is the St. Paul Center Emmaus Academy. We can learn from biblical scholars like Dr. Scott Hahn, Dr. John Bergsma, my "monk-friend" Fr. Boniface Hicks, and more. The Emmaus Academy gives anyone seeking serious Scripture study the resources needed to grow in faith and understanding with online short courses, book studies and more.
