

Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. 


This weekend, as our Church celebrates our Blessed Mother Mary in the month of May, our nation pauses in a wonderful way to celebrate *all* mothers and to thank them for their enormous contribution to our lives and our entire society. Here is a lovely reflection I found from the USCCB:

"A mother's love is first seen even before a woman becomes a mother. A husband and wife's mutual desire to conceive a child itself demonstrates their fatherly and motherly love. And their love for one another extends to the child they lovingly desire to conceive."

A mother's love for her child is so strong, we often see it reflected in nature. Who doesn't know the lengths a mama bear will go to in order to protect her cubs! Today, we thank God and pray for all mothers: mothers both living and deceased; those who rejoice at the birth of their child, and those mourning a loss; those who struggle in any way; and those who are mothers at heart, and who pray to conceive so they can share their love with a child. To all our moms: Thank you! And may God bless you!

Note: In many places in the Northeast, Thursday, May 18, would mark the day Our Lord ascended into heaven after forty days: "[Jesus] presented Himself alive to them by many proofs after He had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the Kingdom of God (Acts 1:3)." However, liturgically in most of the United States (including our diocese), the celebration of this feast is moved to this coming Sunday. So, if you have just joined us from a diocese that celebrates the Ascension on Thursday, please note that this Thursday is not a Holy Day of Obligation here.

My dear sisters in Christ,


Prayer for Mothers
