Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.



RECTOR'S CORNER

Corpus Christi - 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

June is the month of Humility, *not* Humility's opposite. This is nothing new for us as Catholics. Literally for centuries, June has been the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the month when we ask Our Lord in a special way to help us conquer our pride and replace it with His humility. "O Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto thine."

It used to be that the pursuit of virtue over vice was the preoccupation of even non-religious people. Not that long ago, the so-called "new atheists" assured all that one does not have to have religion to be a virtuous person. Today it seems, what was universally known as virtue is often vilified, and obvious vice is made the victor. Try as we might, we cannot get away from the effects of original sin on the human race.

But... God did not leave us orphans (see St. John 14:18). Instead, God pursues us, pouring grace upon us at every turn that we might turn back to Him. Created in God's own image, He will never abandon us, constantly seeking to save us as the "Hound of Heaven" (the name of a fantastic poem by Francis Thompson). "Despite every attempt to escape, hide, or elude the mighty hound, Thompson cannot do so, ultimately surrendering to being caught, only to find that this creature, which he mightily feared, is actually his very salvation" (Bishop Donald J. Hying, 2020).

Today, we celebrate the great feast of Corpus Christi – the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This is another "Feast of the Humility of God." The mystery of the Risen Christ at Easter is so powerful that it "reverberates" in a sense for weeks past Pentecost. Last Sunday, we contemplated the Most Holy Trinity, the central revelation of our faith. Today as we celebrate Corpus Christi, we meditate more deeply upon the Real Presence of Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament, our food for this journey of faith. This celebration draws our attention more fully to Jesus' *continued Presence* among us upon all of our altars and within all of the tabernacles of the world.

St. Francis of Assisi wrote: "O sublime humility! O humble sublimity! That the Lord of the universe, God and the Son of God, so humbles Himself that for our salvation He hides Himself under the little form of bread! Look, brothers, at the humility of God, and pour out your hearts before Him!"

Join us today for our annual Eucharistic Procession at the conclusion of the 11:15am Mass as Our Lord walks with us and blesses our very streets with His humble, sublime Presence. Afterwards, join us for our parish picnic on the lawn. Before this mystery, we pray again, "O Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto yours!"

All praise to Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament! Father Wilson


