Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. RECTOR'S CORNER

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time – 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We have arrived once again in "Ordinary Time." Did you ever wonder what "Ordinary Time" really means? Well, first of all, in spite of what the English word sounds like, it is not "plain," or "everyday," or "uninteresting." Recall we are a global faith with an equally global language and vocabulary. "Ordinary Time" is a translation of Tempus per Annum, which literally means "Time (or Season) During the Year." Whereas the liturgical seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter, all have their particular character and turn our attention to more specific Mysteries of the life of Christ, Ordinary Time is meant to capture the meaning of Sunday in its fullness as lived throughout the year. After all, every Sunday (the first day of the week) is literally a "little Easter." This is why we gather on Sunday – the Lord's Day – the day of both the First and the new Creation – the glorious day of the week on which Our Lord rose and conquered death forever.

The term "Ordinary" also refers to the ordinal numbers (1, 2, 3, 4, etc.), which is why this Sunday is the 11th Sunday, next Sunday is the 12th Sunday, and so on. We could just as easily call this "Ordered Time" since the Sundays are in sequential order.

Sometimes, the largest of our feasts such as All Saints Day, Sts. Peter and Paul, the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and more, will take the place of an Ordinary Sunday; but this is relatively rare. The 34th and last Sunday always crowns the end of the liturgical year with the celebration of Christ the King.

The primary color of Ordinary Time is green, a color representing life and growth (think of the leaves on trees). It is also the color associated with hope, which, like growing things, is always new and fresh.

Speaking of departures from Ordinary Time, next Sunday, June 25th, we will transfer the primary feast of our parish and diocesan patron, St. John the Baptist, to this day from its normal home on June 24th. Our Bishop will be here at the 11:15am Mass to celebrate this important feast for both our parish and diocese – the Nativity of St. John the Baptist.

Also, please welcome Bishop Fabre twice this weekend as he celebrates the holy Sacrament of Confirmation for several of our wonderful young men and women Saturday, June 17th at the 5:30pm Mass. Then, the Bishop will join us again for 9am Mass the next morning as our nation celebrates Father's Day. As we pray for our fathers, let us also pray for our Bishop, who is our spiritual father.

Let us pray for each other, Father Wilson

O God, bless all our fathers. We ask you to grant them wisdom and humility for living out their vocation. Give them the strength to do well by their children and by You. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen.
