Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. The Nativity of St. John the Baptist (transferred)

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Good news abounds! First of all, we celebrate the major feastday of the Patron of both our Cathedral parish and the Diocese of Charleston – the Nativity of St. John the Baptist – transferred from its usual home on June 24. Holy Mother Church only celebrates three actual birthdays – nativities – in the liturgical calendar: Our Lord Jesus Christ (Dec. 25), the Blessed Virgin Mary (Sept. 8), and the cousin of Our Lord and Our Lady, St. John the Baptist (June 24).

The Church places the celebration of their nativities on opposite sides of the calendar. Recalling that Jesus was born in the northern hemisphere, St. John's birthday comes as the length of daylight begins to wane after the summer solstice, while Jesus' birthday comes after the winter solstice and light begins to come back into the sky. This images St. John's own words about Jesus, "He must increase; I must decrease" (Gospel of John 3:30). As we reflect upon our Patron's feast, we can ask ourselves how we can decrease our egos and selfish desires so that Jesus may be seen to increase in us through our words and our deeds.

More good news... As I mentioned at the Masses on June 10 and 11, the Cathedral parish is blessed to receive a parochial vicar beginning July 1. Next weekend, let us all give a warm Cathedral welcome to newly ordained priest, Fr. Paul Lacombe! Father Lacombe will be introducing himself at all Masses and in the bulletin. Welcome, Father Lacombe!

The welcome continues... You may recall a couple of months ago that we were searching for a Director of Evangelization and Faith Formation (DEFF) for the Cathedral parish. We had quite a number of very fine people apply, and I'm happy to report that Brian Barnwell will take this position also beginning July 1. Brian is full of energy and great zeal for our divine faith. Be sure to see the bulletin next week as Brian tells us a bit about himself. Welcome, Brian!

What is a Director of Evangelization and Faith Formation? This position includes the familiar role of DRE (Director of Religious Education) but greatly expanded. In addition to the DRE role of coordinating our K-12 Sunday school program, the DEFF will also coordinate renewed youth and family faith formation programs and events with the help of volunteers. The DEFF will look for new ways to evangelize both those who come to Mass regularly as well as our brothers and sisters who need help seeing and experiencing the beauty of the great gift of Holy Mass. More Scripture studies, book studies, retreats, missions, social media communications will also be in the works through this office. Finally, the DEFF will work closely with our Cathedral Young Adults to continue to grow this marvelous group. Please pray for Brian as he undertakes this vital role in our parish.
