

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time – 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

And summer marches on... August is nearly upon us. People have been enjoying well-deserved vacations, and I hope that you, too, can find some time apart this summer. We've enjoyed many visitors to Charleston and to the Cathedral in particular. It's hard to believe that in about a month, school will begin yet another new year. *Tempus fugit* my grandmother's clock said – "Time flies."

It is a good thing to pause and remind ourselves of the value and sacredness of time itself. *This* time – today – is given to us as an invaluable gift. Let us learn to use it ever more wisely with the help of God's grace from the gifts of His divine life within us – the Sacraments – to bring faith, hope, and love to our families, to our friends, to visitors and guests, and within ourselves. Time is precious and, except in movies alone, our experience of it marches in one direction only... forward. Never wish time away; it never comes back. We must cherish each moment as a precious gift, and value each soul as the priceless treasure he or she is.

As I mentioned in a previous column, last week I was with our diocesan seminarians for their annual summer convocation. We gathered on beautiful Seabrook Island for prayer, formation, and a chance for our seminarians to spend some valuable "down time" getting to know each other. As the diocesan Director of Seminarians, I had the opportunity to speak individually with 16 of our 19 current seminarians (three have been experiencing a special Spanish immersion in Guatemala). I have to say, spending this time with them has given me such hope for our future priests. These men truly are striving to be not "just priests," but holy priests of Jesus Christ for you, the people of God. We have many more men who have expressed interest and will, God willing, soon begin the application process. Please pray for their discernment and continue to "ask the Master of the harvest to send out laborers for His harvest" (St. Matthew 9:38).

World Youth Day has arrived! Over 1,300 groups of more than 28,600 individuals from across the United States will travel to Lisbon, Portugal, for the thirty-seventh World Youth Day gathering (WYD) with Pope Francis. Registration numbers continue to rise. The United States is among the five largest delegations. Most U.S. pilgrims to WYD are young adults between the ages of 18 and 25. Bishop Jacques Fabre-Jeune is already leading a pilgrimage of youth from our diocese, which will visit Lourdes in France, Santiago de Compostela in Spain, and Fatima in Portugal, where our Blessed Mother appeared to the three shepherd children in 1917. The diocesan pilgrimage culminates in the celebration of WYD August 1-6. Please pray for our young people as they long to see Jesus and experience His unfathomable love.

## **Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy**

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

**Sacrament of Marriage:** Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. The bride/groom must meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements. The Wedding Policy Booklet may be found on the Cathedral Website. **Baptisms:** Parents desiring Baptism of their children must be registered at the Cathedral Parish and meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements. 
