The Transfiguration of the Lord

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

All summer long, we have been blessed to have with us our summer seminarian, Philippe Dubour-dieu. Philippe's home parish is Stella Maris on nearby Sullivan's Island. Philippe is attending St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe, PA. There, he will join two of our Cathedral seminarian-parishioners, Michael Tracy and John Erwin. Another Cathedral parishioner, John McBurney, has just left to begin college-level seminary at St. John Vianney Seminary in Miami, FL. In total, we will have twenty men in formation for the holy priesthood in four seminaries. We also had an additional seminarian, Aaron Siehr, from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, who was with us completing a hospital chaplaincy program here in Charleston.

Please pray for all these men, who, like the first Apostles, are seeking to follow Christ in the same way – leaving all behind to serve the flock of Christ and proclaim the faith. But Jesus promises so much more in this sacrifice:

"Amen, I say to you, there is no one who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands for my sake and for the sake of the gospel who will not receive a hundred times more now in this present age: houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and eternal life in the age to come" (St. Mark 10:29-30).

To a young man reading this now who Jesus is calling, pray: "O Lord, give me crosses and thorns, persecutions of all kinds, if only I can save souls, and my own among them. Give me souls, Lord, and take all the rest." – Prayer of St. John Bosco for the Salvation of Souls

The salvation of souls is a serious matter, and our broken world is in urgent need of it. Just the other day, I heard an elected official emphasize the odd juxtaposition of "abortion rights" along with gun control. I was reminded of Pope Francis' comment, "How can an action that ends an innocent and defenseless life in its blossoming stage be therapeutic, civilized or simply human? I ask you: Is it right to 'do away with' a human life in order to solve a problem? Is it right to hire a hitman in order to solve a problem? One cannot. It is not right to 'do away with' a human being, however small, in order to solve a problem."

What will keep us focused and on the right track is two-fold: the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and humility. There is a long tradition in the Church of reminding ourselves of the power Christ's Sacrifice holds. As the Sacred Host is held aloft after the consecration, say silently in your heart the words of St. Thomas the Apostle, "My Lord and my God!" (John 20:28). As the chalice is held high, say again silently in your heart, "Be mindful of thy creature, O Lord, whom thou hast redeemed by thy Most Precious Blood."

And let us continually pray for each other! Father Wilson

Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Placing your envelope in the Sunday collection basket is an important aspect of parish stewardship. We are not called to make an equal gift but an equal sacrifice in proportion to the blessings given to us by God. The offertory basket carried in procession to the altar symbolizes our shared sacrifice offered to the Lord in thanksgiving. Placing your envelope in the basket, even if you have given electronically, symbolizes our share responsibility to support the Church and our parish and a communal offering of thanks.

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box "I attended Mass and/or gave electronically" on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection basket. All envelopes in the collection basket are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as Inactive and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes please contact Stephanie Stewart at executive.assistant@charlestoncathedral.com.

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation.
