RECTOR'S CORNER

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time – 2023

Is Mass fun? If not, should it be fun? There are a lot of things we do in life and things we spend our time on not because it is fun, but because it is meaningful. Establishing and maintaining relationships with other people is not always fun, but it satisfies our need for community. Working on our health is not always fun, but it allows us to feel better in the long run and to be around for those whom we love.

In fact, when it comes to the things that matter in life, being "fun" or not is one of the least important things we consider before choosing to do them. We do these things for two reasons: it is the right thing to do, and it is good for us. Whether we have realized it or not, there is nothing that matters more in life than the Holy Mass. All those other things that matter to us – our relationships, our health, our jobs – are only possible and only matter because of what happens during the Mass.

The reason why Mass is the most important part of our lives is because it is where we can have a personal and physical encounter with Jesus Christ himself in the Most Holy Eucharist. Think of your relationships with those you love – how successful are those relationships going to be if it's a one-way street. How can we expect to foster relationships with others if we give and do not receive, or receive and do not give?

The Mass can be considered as the time we spend with God in our relationship with Him. Calling someone, texting, or thinking about him or her is great, but we can't expect this to lead to meaningful growth in our relationship with that person we say we love. We need to spend time in their presence to do that. We can pray to God and think about Him often, but if we do not spend personal time with Him in the Mass and before the Blessed Sacrament, our relationship will grow stagnant. The sad part is that God is always offering His time and presence to us, but sometimes we either don't accept it or don't reflect enough to appreciate it.

Like all our relationships, you will get out what you put in from the Mass. If you approach Mass reluctantly because it's not "fun" enough, you will resent being in the presence of God. Instead, approach Mass this way: I am not coming to have fun, I'm coming to find meaning. I am coming to work on my loving relationship to God, who first loved me.

Preparing for Mass does not begin when we walk into the church. All the preparation we do before the Mass, from fasting an hour before to genuflecting, blessing ourselves with holy water, and kneeling in prayer, is done because of the Eucharist. We are Catholic and have inherited the Holy Mass from the earliest foundation of our Church by Jesus Christ Himself. There is nothing more meaningful in our life than being in His presence.

Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. 
