29th Sunday in Ordinary Time – 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

First, please make note: All the priests of the Diocese will be on our annual retreat, this year in Hendersonville, N.C., from Monday, October 23 through Thursday, October 26. **There will be no confessions or daily Mass during these days.** Mass and confessions will resume as normal on Friday, October 27. Days of retreat are required by the Church for her priests to help renew us and keep us focused on our mission, which is to bring Jesus Christ to you through not only the celebration of the Sacraments, but by the manner of our daily lives. I humbly ask you to please pray for all of us during these special days. Know that I will be offering Holy Mass for you and your intentions.

People often say they would love to "get more involved" and volunteer. Well, now is your chance! The Cathedral is having a Ministry Fair to highlight the many ways you can volunteer and other ways to deepen your faith. Come by the parish hall on Sunday, October 29, after both the 9am and 11:15am Masses.

Even if you have only a casual connection to the latest news, it is hard to miss the strife that is going on in the Holy Land. It has always seemed ironic that the name "Jerusalem" means "City of Peace." (The words "salem" and "shalom" are linguistically connected.) Along with praying for peace, we also pray for the protection of our Christian brothers and sisters living there, caught in the crossfire, and worshipping every day at the holy sites of our Lord and His Saints.

On the weekend of October 28-29, you will have the opportunity to help our struggling Christians brothers and sisters through the purchase of handmade olive wood items and carvings. This gives them work so that they can continue to live in the land where God walked. We will welcome Rami Qumsieh, who brings us their items including rosaries, icons, a variety of crosses, statues, and more. By your holy Resurrection, O Lord, we pray you bring peace to the land made holy by your presence and your Blood. Amen.

Mark your calendars for our **upcoming Holy Day of Obligation**, **All Saints Day**, **November 1**. Masses for the Holy Day on November 1 are at 8am, 12 noon, and Solemn Mass at 7pm. For our Solemn Mass, the Cathedral Choir will sing Victoria's *Missa O quam gloriosum* along with works by composer William Byrd.

The next day, although not a day of obligation, is our special commemoration of all the Faithful Departed – All Souls Day, November 2. This begins a month of praying for our departed loved ones. Let us remember also those who have no one to pray for them. Masses for All Souls Day are at 7am, 12 noon, and a Solemn Requiem Mass at 7pm with Fauré's beloved *Requiem*. (Please note that this Mass is in the *Ordinary* Form.)

Cathedral Active Parishioner Policy

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least 3 months.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Sacrament of Marriage: Either bride or groom must be registered at the Cathedral at least 12 months before scheduling a date and beginning the 6 month marriage preparation. Baptisms: Parents desiring Baptism of their children must be registered at the Cathedral Parish and meet the Active Parishioner Policy requirements.
