

RECTOR'S CORNER

+JMJ+

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I hope that this November is blessed for you as we gradually transition from Ordinary Time into Advent. A little tidbit about Ordinary Time is the significance of the name in English. In Latin, we refer to the period between Christmas and Lent, and to the period between Pentecost and Advent, as tempus per annum, which means, time of the year. The word Ordinary here is the adjectival form of the word Ordinal. So, the Church does not intend communicate that these 34, or so, weeks are usual or routine, but counted in a series. During these ordinal weeks, the Church digests more general, universal themes than she does during the other seasons of the liturgical calendar, where she emphasizes and focuses upon more specific themes. In these last ordinal weeks, the Lectionary and Missal begin to transition their focus to themes of the last judgment and the triumphant return of the King at the end of days. And, beautifully enough, these are the very themes that Advent picks up with!

While we wait for our King to come back in all His Glory, here at the Cathedral we are keeping busy, especially by emphasizing our outreach to our youth and young adults. In our present day and age, our youth and our young adults have unique needs, struggles, and gifts. Like all of us, these precious and beloved members of the Church need accompaniment and love. To that end, as the newly appointed chaplain to our Parish young adults (Catholics 18 to 35), I have been working hard with Brian Barnwell to provide structure to our outreach to the young adults. If you, or someone you love, is a young adult, spread the word! We meet weekly for a Faith Study on Thursdays at 7pm. We are finishing a series called Genesis to Jesus right now, but will soon begin a Biblical Walkthrough of the Mass. On November 30th, we will have a young adult potluck – we need some young adults to scrounge up some scrumptious things to share! The potluck starts at 7pm, and will include a talk about Conversion.

Lastly, Christ the King Sunday, November 26th, (our last Sunday before Advent), has been declared a Global Celebration for Youth and Young Adults. Don't worry, we won't try to cram the whole globe into the Cathedral on that day, but we are warmly inviting all local youth and young adults to attend the 11:15am Mass at the Cathedral that day with our Bishop.

I am grateful everyday to be assigned to the Cathedral Parish and to be one of your priests! Please continue to pray for me. I'm praying for you!!

Cathedral Active Parishioner Guide

How do I know if I am an active part of the Cathedral parish family?

The Cathedral is able to operate only because of the generosity of our "family."

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

- 1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for a sufficient amount of time.
- 2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
- 3. Contributes financially to the parish according to one's means.
- 4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)

Active status in our database is essential for consideration of the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate as CCS and BE High School
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Holy Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, or Holy Matrimony (for oneself or for one's children, either at Cathedral or in another parish)

Sacrament of Holy Matrimony: Congratulations! The world truly needs strong, faithful couples. Our parish stands ready to help prepare you for your life together in Christ through this holy Sacrament. The Diocese of Charleston requires a minimum of 6 months preparation for the Sacrament, so please contact us as soon as you are engaged so that we can share your joy and begin the process of preparation and reserving a date for your special day. Please understand that not all dates and times at the Cathedral may be available. Also, to receive the added benefits of being a Cathedral parishioner, either the bride or groom must be registered for a sufficient time before reserving a date. For help in understanding what it means to have a home here at the parish, please see the Active Parishioner Guide. A comprehensive set of Wedding guidelines may be found on the Cathedral Website. Holy Baptism: The birth of your child is such a gift! Let the Cathedral parish help you give the gift of new birth through the waters of Holy Baptism. For a child to receive Baptism at the Cathedral, please note that at least one parent must be a practicing Catholic, regularly attend Holy Mass, participating in the life of the parish, and be registered at the Cathedral for a sufficient time prior to requesting the date. In this, you become part of our wider parish family! First-time parents must attend our Baptismal Preparation session prior to the Baptism. Godparents are encouraged to attend a Baptismal Preparation session as well. Since godparents promise to help raise your child in the practice of the Catholic faith, godparents must be practicing Catholics at whatever parish they attend.
