

RECTOR'S CORNER

Gaudete Sunday – 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

When I was last assigned to the Cathedral, I walked out on this third Sunday of Advent to open the church for what was then 8am Mass. It was the cusp of dawn, and the entire sky was teeming with brilliant, rose-colored clouds, which just happens to be the liturgical color of this Sunday! We celebrate today Gaudete Sunday – the Sunday of Joy. The entrance text for the Mass (known as the Introit) comes from St. Paul's epistle to the Philippians, "Gaudete!... Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! Your kindness should be known to all. The Lord is near" (4:4-5). The vestments that the priest and deacon wear along with the third candle of the Advent wreath are colored rose – the color of hope and anticipation since it is the color of the sky just before the dawn.

We have many reasons to be joyful. For one, the solemn celebration of the Incarnation of our God is almost here. "Incarnation" literally means "taking on flesh." We celebrate the amazing fact that God the Son, the eternal, Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity, through the power of the Holy Spirit, took on human flesh in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary and was born for us at Christmas to be our Savior. Also, with Jesus' own Body and Blood as our spiritual food, we can find His joy even in the midst of hardships and uncertainty. Utilize these last days of Advent to slow down and prepare spiritually to receive the Lord in your heart.

In one short week, Christmas will be here! This is the shortest Advent season possible since Christmas Day falls on Monday, the 25th . Christmas Day is always a Holy Day of Obligation and so is the Fourth Sunday of Advent, celebrated on the evening of December 23 and the morning of the 24th . The question always comes up, "Do I have to go to Mass twice?" The best answer is, "Yes, you *get* to go to Mass twice!!" Like spouses who joyfully live the obligation to be faithful, we realize the festive opportunity these two important Masses hold. Keep in mind, if you want to "spread things apart" more, if you usually go to Mass on Christmas Eve, you could attend the Saturday vigil of the 4th Sunday of Advent on the 23rd . Also, you could go to the 4th Sunday of Advent on the morning of the 24th and then the 10am Mass of Christmas Day. So many options!

Here again is the schedule of Masses for both the Fourth Sunday of Advent and Christmas, which this year fall back-to-back:

4th Sunday of Advent: Saturday, December 23 at 5:30pm; Sunday, December 24 at 9am and 11:15am.

<u>Christmas Masses</u>: Sunday, December 24, Vigil Masses at 5pm and 7pm. Then, Midnight Mass begins at midnight (12am) with our Cathedral Choir's lovely musical prelude beginning at 11:15pm. Monday, December 25, the Mass of Christmas Day at 10am.
