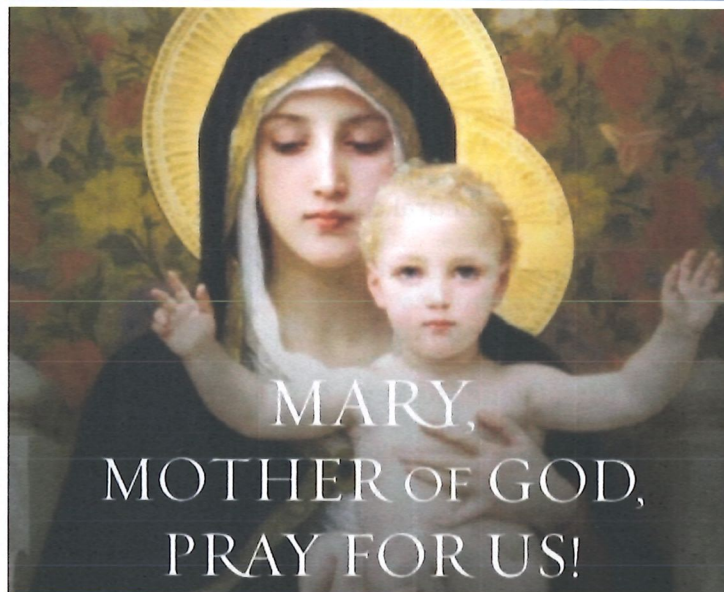

4th Sunday of Advent – Christmas – 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

If you are visiting with us, welcome! We bring to conclusion the shortest Advent possible and commence the celebration of the glorious feast of Christmas. Christmas Masses often bring many visitors to our parish, including many family members and friends of parishioners. May you find a warm welcome here as we together celebrate the birth of the Savior of the world, Our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Please note that for next week's solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, on January 1, 2024, we will only have one Mass, which will be at 10:00am. (Because January 1 falls on a Monday, the obligation to attend the Holy Day Mass is lifted this year.)

On a liturgical note, for the Masses of Christmas, we genuflect out of reverence for the Incarnation of God during the words of the Creed, "and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man." God has come down to save us in love, and so we likewise bow down low in love, wonder, and awe.

We live in the midst of so many who are desperately seeking something in life, but refusing to give real consideration to what we know is true: that the world's wait for a savior ended with the birth of that Babe in Bethlehem's manger, the One whose birth we pause to celebrate.

Here are a few poignant words for us to ponder:

"Is the humanity of our time still waiting for a Savior? One has the feeling that many consider God as foreign to their own interests. Apparently, they do not need Him. They live as though He did not exist and, worse still, as though He were an 'obstacle' to remove in order to fulfill themselves. Even among believers, some let themselves be attracted by enticing dreams and distracted by misleading doctrines that suggest deceptive shortcuts to happiness. Yet, despite its contradictions, worries, and tragedies, and perhaps precisely because of them, humanity today seeks a path of renewal, of salvation; it seeks a Savior and awaits, sometimes unconsciously, the coming of the Savior who renews the world and our life, the coming of Christ, the one true Redeemer of man and of the whole of man." (Pope Benedict XVI – 2006)

As you leave all Masses this weekend, please accept the gift of a book by renowned Catholic author Matthew Kelly. It's a free gift for everyone – visitor and parishioner alike – made possible through the tremendous generosity of an anonymous donor. Take, read, be uplifted, and then pass it on the gift.

This Christmas know that your intentions and those of your loved ones will be remembered in all of my Christmas Masses. On behalf of Bishop Fabre; Fr. Lacombe; our Deacons Tom Baranoski, Jim Letendre, and Charles Olimpio, I wish each of you, parishioners, visitors, and all your families, a Holy and Merry Christmas.

O come, let us adore Him!

1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for a sufficient amount of time.
2. Attends Mass at Cathedral at least 75% of all Sundays.
3. Contributes financially to the parish according to one's means.
4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, even if empty. (If you forgot your envelope there are extra envelopes in the pews and tables at the back of the church.)
