#### RECTOR'S CORNER

Feast of the Holy Family – 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Merry Christmas! We have only just begun our Church's Christmas season, so "Merry Christmas!" is *still* our appropriate Christian greeting for each other, at least through Epiphany. They call it the twelve days of Christmas for a reason, after all. I think they even wrote a song about it...

First, regarding the January 1st Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God: Normally, this is a Holy Day of Obligation; however, since this year the feast falls on a Monday, this obligation is lifted. It is still a holy day, of course. The Cathedral will have one Mass on New Year's Day for the solemnity at 10:00am.

Second, a reminder that beginning next Sunday, January 7, the Cathedral will host a weekly Mass in the Spanish language at 6pm. This has been our bishop's desire since he was ordained. It is, of course, open to all.

The Sunday between Christmas and the Epiphany is Holy Family Sunday. Yearly, Holy Mother Church invites us to ponder the example of the family life of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, the shining model for all Christian families. If you are called to the vocation of Christian family life, then use this celebration to ask the Holy Family to bless and guide you in your vocation. Are you a husband and father? Then, strive to be the best one ever. Why settle for less? Are you a wife and mother? Then, endeavor to be the best one who ever lived. Again, why settle for less? Are you a child? (Including teens on this one!) Be a light to your family, helping to show them the way as did the Child Jesus, who eventually became the "Teen Jesus." We cannot settle for being anything less than a saint, because only saints go to heaven. Praise God for His mercy, grace, and forgiveness to help us when we fall to start again and again on the path to holiness of life. Be a light wherever God has placed you.

A final reflection about the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. The three members of this family helped each other to discover God's plan. They prayed, worked, communicated. Importantly, they communicated with *each other*. Do I know how to communicate, or am I like so many families at the table, each one with their mobile phones out, texting away to others? There's a silence at these tables as if they were at Mass. But they are not communicating with each other. We must learn to talk again as a family: fathers, parents, sons, grandparents and siblings must communicate with one another. This is today's homework as we look to the Holy Family of Nazareth. May the love of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph help all families to grow in grace and holiness through real, physical interaction with one another.

So, put away those phones and talk ... to each other!


