

#### RECTOR'S CORNER

The Epiphany of the Lord – 2024 Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Merry "Little Christmas!" Traditionally, the Epiphany of the Lord closes out the major celebrations of the Christmas season, which will continue through this week until the Baptism of the Lord. Although the secular world may have stripped and thrown trees to the curb, returned decorations to a dusty attic, and reverted its gaze to the world below, we disciples of Jesus Christ know that the joy of the Incarnation cannot be constrained so narrowly. Our joy continues.

"Epiphany" comes from a Greek word that means "manifestation," and means "to make something known." From our Catechism: "The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Savior of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the East, together with His baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee. In the magi, ... the Gospel sees the first-fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation." (CCC 528)

With accelerated bulletin deadlines the norm during holidays, this column is the first in which I can address the declaration from the Vatican Fiducia supplicans (FS). You would think from the secular headlines in various publications that an earthquake had occurred in Catholic doctrine. This is not the case. Please know that the Church has not changed her divine teaching on Christian marriage – a.k.a., holy matrimony, which reflects the fruitful, heavenly love of Christ and His Bride, the Church.

"Some of the secular world willingly views FS as a reversal of teaching, that the Catholic Church now upholds homosexual unions. This is not the case. Blessings are not a new practice in our faith, and the blessings discussed in FS are inadmissible if they in any way cause public scandal, affirm irregular or same-sex unions or celebrate sin. To quote the document directly, '... This Declaration remains firm on the traditional doctrine of the Church about marriage, not allowing any type of liturgical rite or blessing similar to a liturgical rite that can create confusion' " (Bishop Fabre).

Those with same-sex attractions "need encouragement to persevere and guidance to follow Christ in their call to holiness and bravely carrying this cross." The Bishop also asks us all to pray for the our Holy Father, "especially for the Holy Spirit to guide him as the head of the Church on earth. The papacy is a heavy responsibility, and our pope needs the support which the prayers of the laity help to provide."

I find these words from our Bishop particularly inspiring: "Finally, we as a Church are called to be countercultural; this especially pertains to the family unit. Our nation and our world have twisted the definition of love and union, words that are beautiful and essential for Christian living. So let us be beacons of light and truth for those steeped in darkness and confusion. Let us act as messengers of the Word Made Flesh and proclaim the Gospel always."

O come, let us adore Him! Father Wilson




