

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last week's oyster roast was a great success! If you missed it, be sure to catch it next year. Or, better yet, come instead to our upcoming Cathedral Women's Club's Parish Dessert Competition, February 4, after the 11:15am Mass! Enjoy sampling the confectionary talent of our contestants. Although our faith usually tells us not to judge, I will be a willing referee in this contest! Come see who wins sweet victory.

These words from St. Paul's letter to Timothy seem prophetic in modern times:

"For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear." (2 Timothy 4:3-4)

In our age, confusion seems to be more the norm. Many disagree about points of doctrine and morality that are at the very core of our faith. This state of affairs can be incredibly frustrating to the disciple truly seeking to know God. How are we to recognize what is truly sound teaching? The answer is: the Church that Jesus founded. By studying our faith, we first and foremost get to know the Person behind the faith – Jesus Christ. We will grow in knowledge of Him and in our devotion to Him. And, we won't feel so "lost" when someone challenges us on some point of our faith.

Last week, I encouraged you to check out the *Institute of Catholic Culture* and their incredible amount of free podcasts on all kind of subjects about the faith. You can download their app or go online to <u>instituteofcatholicculture.org</u>.

This week, I would like to highlight a free service offered through our parish, which I had mentioned many months ago in my column, called FORMED. There are Bible studies, movies, prayers, books, educational series on the Sacraments, stuff for kids, and so much more. It's completely free, so go to www.charlestoncathedral.formed.org and type in "Cathedral of St. John the Baptist Charleston." A menu will appear that will have our address (120 Broad St., Charleston). Click on the address, then follow the instructions. That's it!

Yet another great resource for Catholics, who might like to seek an advanced degree in theology, is the Augustine Institute – <u>augustineinstitute.org</u>. Their graduate degree program can be done via distance education. From their website: "In all our programs of study, the Augustine Institute's interdisciplinary curriculum is designed to lead students to the graced perfection of memory, intellect and will by a devoted study of Sacred Scripture, Sacred Doctrine, Church history, and the various arts of missionary discipleship. In this work of dedicated study, we are accompanied by the Fathers, Doctors, and Saints, as we strive to be formed by the Word of God in fidelity to the Church's living Magisterium." They even allow you to sample three courses.
